L.C.S.C is situated at Boreen Point, Qld, on the shores of Lake Cootharaba, Qld’s largest salt water lake. Gateway to the Cooloola National Park, A coastal lake with steady sea breezes, providing world class sailing conditions.

Boreen Point is a tranquil and scenic village approximately 20 mins north of Noosa, two small general stores, one pub and two caravan parks / camping grounds and one motel complete the commercial sector of the village.

The camping ground at Boreen Point is about 300mt from the club house, it’s a bush type park, great for the kids, with a pristine white sand beach bordering the campsite, safe for the kids, though not recommended to launch centerboard dinghies from. Many of the houses in Boreen Point are available for holiday letting via Boreen Point Real Estate (07 5485 3925) Bookings are not available through Boreen Point Caravan Park, through this can be arranged (Contact Geoff Henry)

The second camping ground is Elanda Point approx 8 minutes drive from L.C.S.C. (07 5485 3165).
